



## 2020 Germantown Girls Winter Shootout - Rules and Information

**DATE:** Saturday, February 29<sup>th</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>  
Sunday, March 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grades

**WIAA rules apply with modifications below:**

- 20 minute Halves, continuous clock until final minute of each half
- 4 minute warm-up before games, as time permits
- 3 minute halftime
- 4 minute Overtime if necessary, continuous clock until final 30 seconds. 2<sup>nd</sup> Overtime, if necessary, will be sudden death – First basket or first 2 free throws.
- 2 full and 2-30 second timeouts per game; no timeouts in overtime, no carryover
- Man to man defense for 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup>; help defense is allowed
- No full court press for 4<sup>th</sup> grade, 5<sup>th</sup> grade may press in final two minutes of half, full court press allowed at all times for 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grades.
- Any defense allowed for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades
- If lead reaches 15 points, no pressing by winning team, clock will become continuous
- Technical fouls will be automatic 2 points and possession
- Two technical fouls on any player or coach during the entire tournament will lead to automatic disqualification
- Officials decisions are final
- Players must be listed on team roster and must have a signed waiver to play
- Round robin bracket winners will be determined by: 1- record, head to head 2- common opponents 3 – least points allowed

**Admission:** \$4 for adults, \$2 for children and seniors, under 5 are free, only two coaches per team will be free. Family discount \$8

**Concessions:** Available at tournament, please no carry-ins except water.

**Basketballs:** Teams must provide their own balls for warm-ups

**Awards:** Awards for 1<sup>st</sup> place and 2<sup>nd</sup> place
